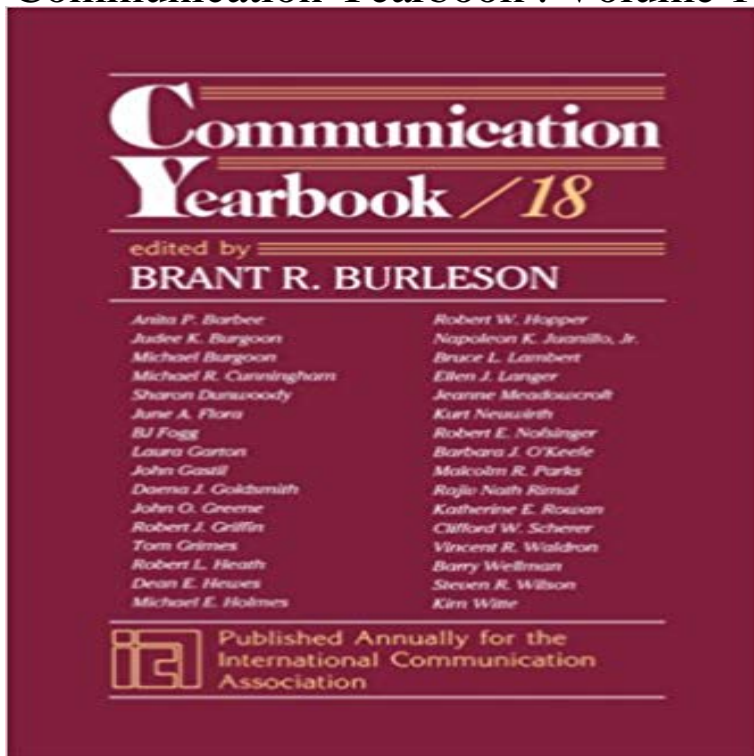


Communication Yearbook : Volume 18
