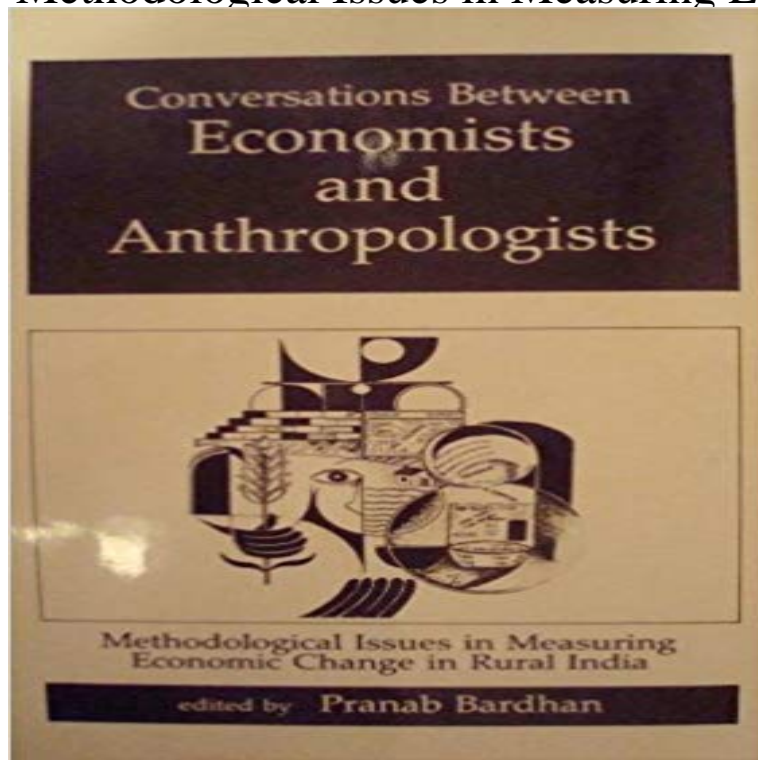


Conversations Between Economists and Anthropologists: Methodological Issues in Measuring Economic Change in Rural India
