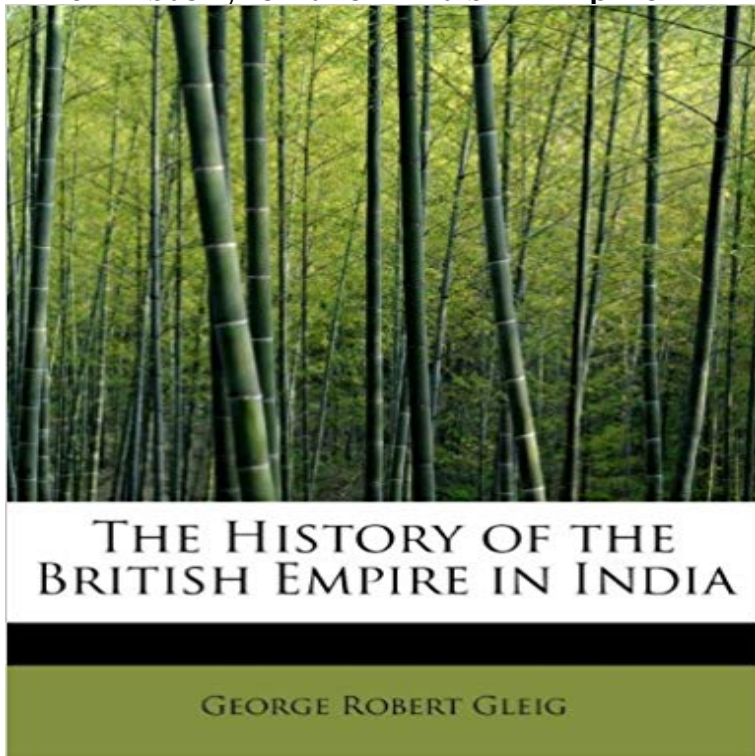


# The History of the British Empire in India
