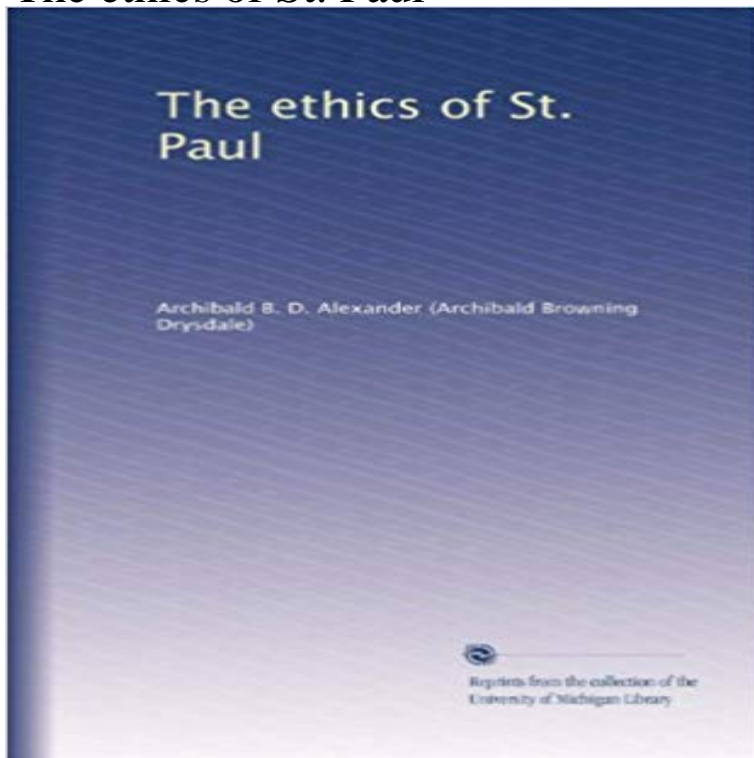


The ethics of St. Paul
