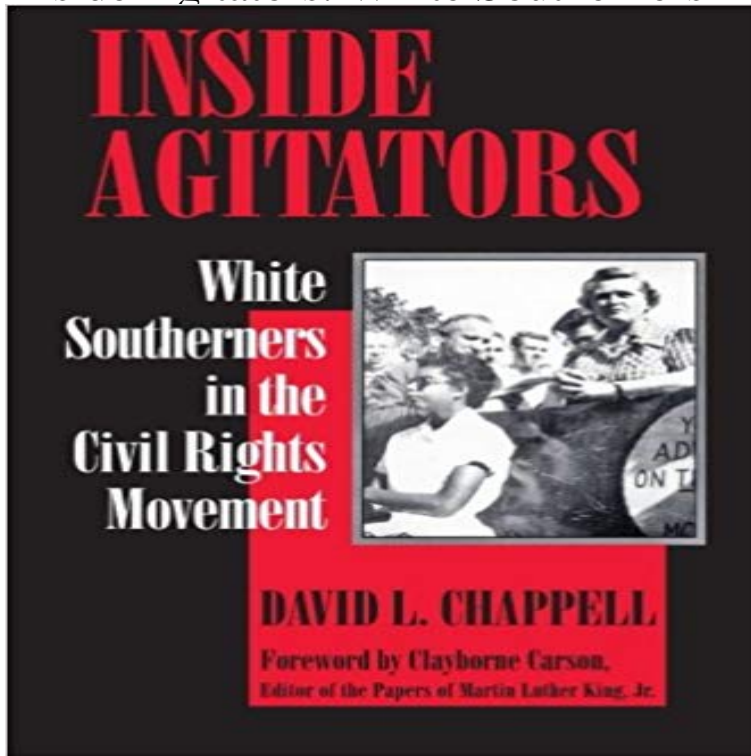


Inside Agitators: White Southerners in the Civil Rights Movement
