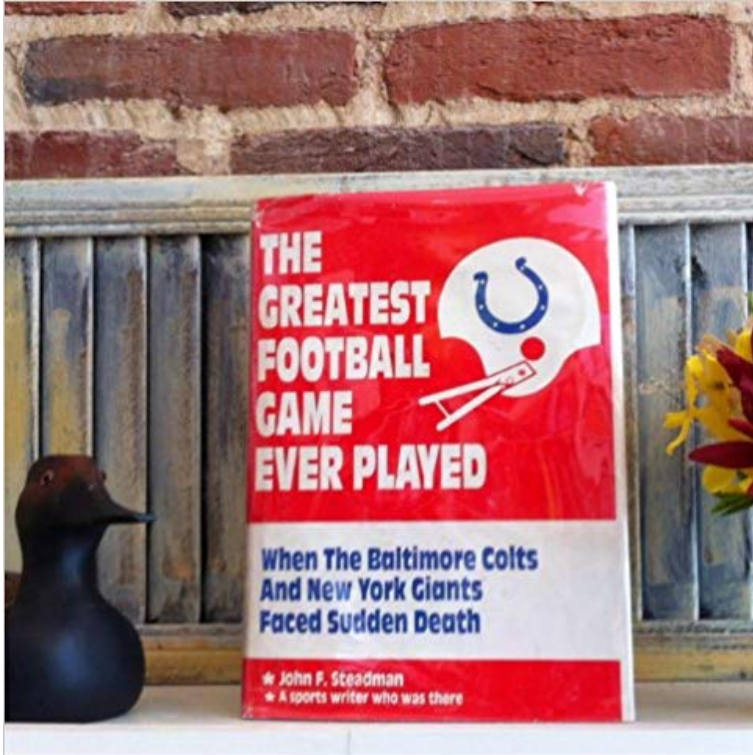


# The Greatest Football Game Ever Played: When the Baltimore Colts and the New York Giants Faced Sudden Death
