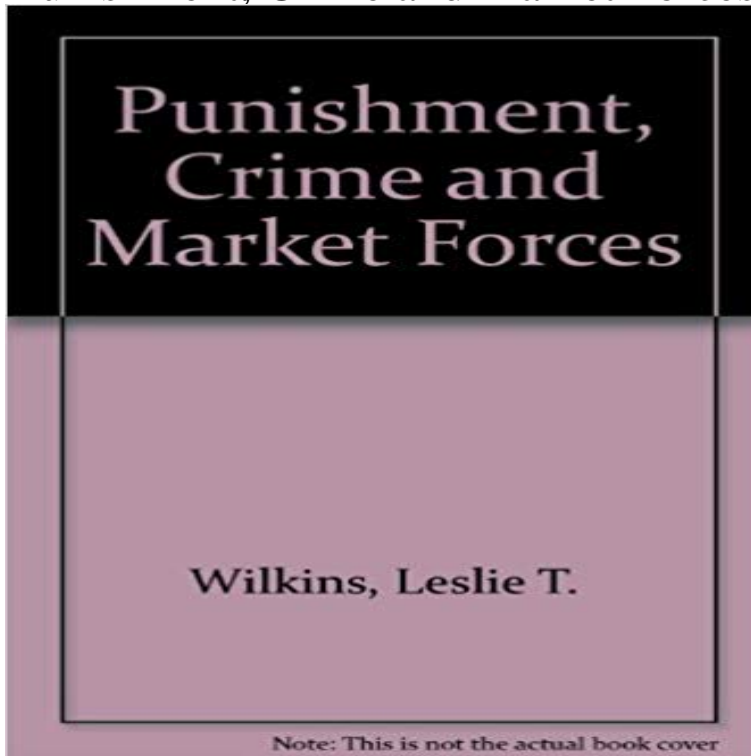


## Punishment, Crime and Market Forces
