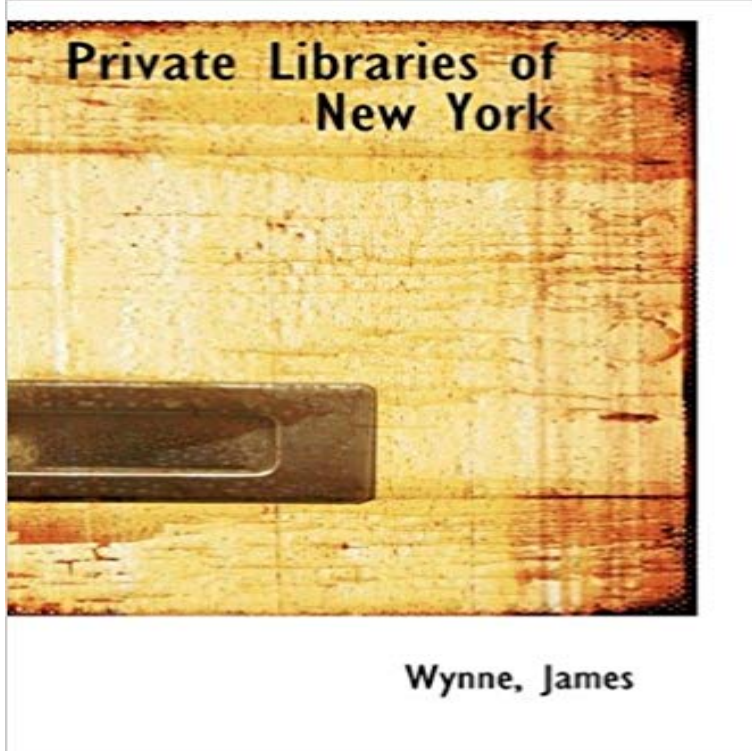


## Private Libraries of New York
