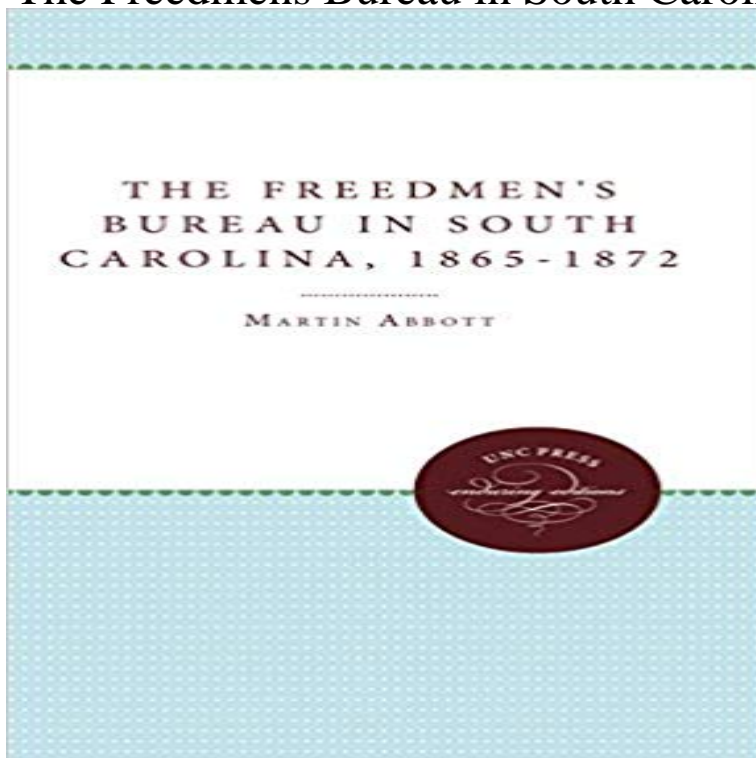


The Freedmens Bureau in South Carolina, 1865 - 1872
