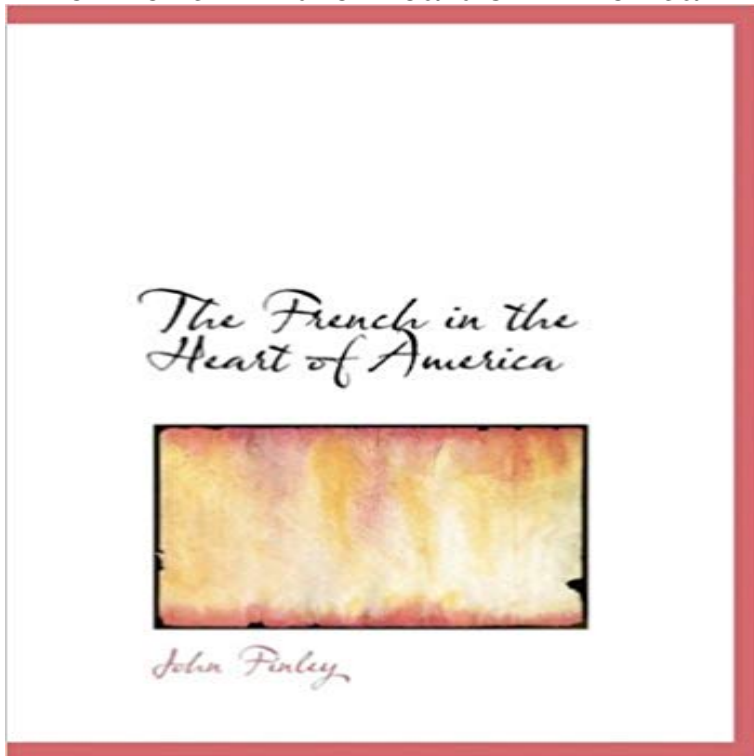


## The French in the Heart of America
