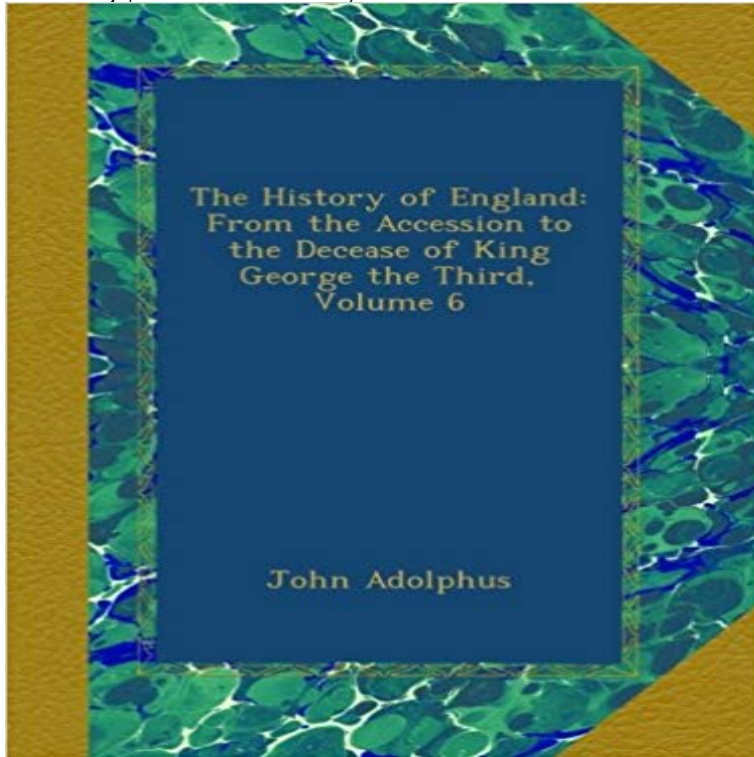


# The History of England: From the Accession to the Decease of King George the Third, Volume 6
